## Apple Pollination Chart

### Note:

The following varieties do not make good pollinizers since these are triploid plants which do not pollinate other trees. These varieties must have another tree to pollinate themselves plus the pollinator will require another to pollinize it: GRAVENSTEIN, JONAGOLD, KING & MUTSU

\* These are the best apples for ripening in Western Washington.

X These are not reliable pollinizers and must have another tree to pollinate.

## **DIRECTIONS for USE :**

1. From the left-hand column select a cultivar you are interested in growing.
  2. Check across the chart; the unmarked boxes will be a reliable pollinizer for the cultivar you have chosen.
