How we share the farm with you

Purchase your entry tickets at the Produce Market and our team will give you parking instructions. Once parked, we will provide you with a map and the fun begins. Follow the beautiful tree-lined boulevard lined with pumpkin fields on the left and the sheep pasture on the right. As you continue straight you will find the pond and park area or turn right to board our tractor pulled wagons and explore the rest of the farm. Every attraction can be enjoyed by walking or wagon...It is up to you!

Riding the Wagon

See the entire 80- acre farm while you enjoy a 30-minute ride on one of our large tractor-pulled wagons. Ride the entire loop. Or, if you prefer to spend a little more time at a location, simply hop off. When you are ready, hop back on at one of our convenient wagon pickup locations throughout the park. You can do this as often as you like. During our busy times, we will include a 2nd wagon to ensure your waiting times are not too long.

What to see

- Enjoy the newly re-modeled Marshland Produce Market where you will find vegetables, fruit, snacks, cider, and other locally grown and sourced items.
- Wander the park, near the pond, cross the bridge, and enjoy the sights of multiple fountains.
- See where we grow our crops...the pumpkin fields, the apple and pear orchards, the Christmas trees, and many other various nursery plants.
- Say hello to our grazing herd of sheep and look for any newly born lambs.
- Explore the “chicken” play field. Named for the thousands of chickens that were originally cooped there, it is now used as a play area for the young and young-at-heart.
- Top off your trip, literally, by climbing the stairs of the living maze’s center tower. Our living maze is slowly recovering from 3 weeks of flood damage but will again be green and beautiful in no time.

Picnic at the Farm

Choose any farm location to have a picnic as long as you are not interfering with farm operations or blocking any roadways. You are welcome to board the wagon with your picnic items as transportation, or you may walk to your chosen location. You will need to provide your own chairs, blankets, food, etc. If you would like a 6–8-person foldable picnic table you may rent one at the Produce Market and we will bring it to your location.

- Do not interfere with any animals or farm operations.
- Obey all signs and please do not disturb planted fields in any way.
- Be aware that there may be farm machinery and equipment near you.
- Enjoy your space and respect the space of others.
- Your well-behaved dog is welcome. We ask that you always keep dogs on a leash.
- Please respect the property by keeping it clean. Trash bins are available.
- There is no potable water on the farm, you can bring your own or purchase bottled water at the Produce Market.
- Portable toilets will be located at various locations throughout the farm for your use.

Please be aware that you are enjoying an operational farm. This means equipment is active, roads may be uneven or bumpy, and crops are being grown around you. For your safety, and the safety of others, please read and obey all posted warning signs.
