Visit the Produce Market to pick up a map as well as parking instructions. Once parked, the fun begins. Follow the beautiful tree-lined boulevard lined with pumpkin fields on the left and the sheep pasture on the right. As you continue straight you will find the pond and park area with our impressive fountains. Every attraction can be enjoyed with a simple walk.

What to See

- Enjoy the newly re-modeled Marshland Produce Market where you will find vegetables, fruit, snacks, cider, and other locally grown and sourced items.
- Wander the park, near the pond, cross the bridge, and enjoy the sights of multiple fountains.
- See where we grow our crops...the pumpkin fields, the apple and pear orchards, the Christmas trees, and many other various nursery plants.
- Say hello to our grazing herd of sheep and look for any newly born lambs.
- Explore the "chicken" play field. Named for the thousands of chickens that were originally cooped there, it is now used as a play area for the young and young-at-heart.
- Top off your trip, literally, by climbing the stairs of the living maze's center tower. Our living maze is slowly recovering from months of flood water damage but will again be green and beautiful in no time.
