Venus Flytrap Care

Venus flytraps are the most remarkable plants in the world!

Care of the Venus flytrap is very easy. These plants will take care of themselves as far as feeding. Did you know that a trap only requires a few insects a year?

Give them a lot of sunlight and water – it will amaze you how they grow and function.

As these plants mature their traps will turn black. All you have to do is cut the black traps off and watch as new traps appear in about six weeks.

In the winter months you should let your flytrap go dormant. Cut back all the leaves, put the bulb (corm) in a Ziploc bag (not sealed) and place in the refrigerator for about 60 days.

Take trap from refrigerator and repot in Canadian peat. Place pot in dish of water and in a window with good sunlight.

You will be amazed at how fast your flytrap grows!
